DEVILSFROSTREPORT broke well stalking WILQUEEN to the quarter pole, moved up three wide to challenge for the lead top of the lane, went clear mid stretch, was kept to a drive holding safe late. DUNWOODY GIRL settled in the second flight, gained ground at the quarter pole, rallied strongly mid stretch, was held safe by the winner late but proved a willing second best. IN A MELLOW TONE well placed saving ground, angled to the three path giving chase in upper stretch, lacked needed kick besting rest. SAKI lost position around the bend, angled upper stretch, mildly bid but never menaced. SANDIPAT settled in mid pack, made a brief bid racing four wide, soon flattened out in the lane. STRATEGIC ZENNA trailed early, past tiring foes, never factored. WILQUEEN sent hard and opened a clear early lead, had nothing left by mid stretch giving way. EDGY BLUE lacked speed, offered little.
