FLYING CORINTHIAN quickly showed in front, was soon pressured by MEGIDDO around the turn, edged away in mid stretch, began to tire in deep stretch and was kept to strong handling to hold safe. GREELY STATION settled towards the inside around the turn, moved up on the field turning for home and waited briefly for room, split rivals inside the eighth pole and surged gamely on the winner nearing the wire missing in a game effort. MEGIDDO broke out brushing SHE GAVE ME LIFE, quickly rushed up to press the winner, battled to upper stretch, tired late managing to save third place under a stiff drive. MY HOT CHILI raced up close from the start, angled out to the three path upper stretch, loomed off the winner giving chase, flattened out being outgamed for a minor award. SHE GAVE ME LIFE was bothered and briefly took up by a veering out MEGIDDO at the break, settled in the second flight, mildly bid in deep stretch traveling towards the inside but was no real threat. BERRA tracked to the quarter pole running four wide, lacked needed rally despite being hard ridden from upper stretch. WILDCAT HUMOR was quickly outrun, never involved. JAZZIN DOWN SOUTH flashed brief foot, stopped in mid stretch and was eased across the finish line. CAPT MORGAN J was always outrun, never factored.
