MARCHING TUNE hustled to the top, set a well rated pace traveling along the inside, was kept to pressure holding firm to the wire. BRASSY BOY settled in good tracking position, swung out five to six wide top of the lane, surged strongly in deep stretch securing second place in a good try. MR. KEEPER stalked the winner from the start, gave chase under an all out drive from top of the stretch, needed a bit more late and was edged out of second place in last jumps. ALL THE GLORY angled to the rail entering the backstretch, advanced along the rail from the quarter pole, loomed inside the eighth pole but flattened out needing more late. JOE KNOWS ALL tracked racing along the inside to the far turn, angled out mid turn, lost ground turning for home running very wide, surged belatedly finishing with interest. BOYFRIENDONTHE SIDE settled towards the rear, roused form the quarter pole, lacked needed response never threatening. HARBOR RIDGE stalked the winner to the far turn racing three wide, began to chase from mid turn, had little left in the drive fading to the wire. SHOW ME THE CASH was in tight and steadied going into the first turn, moved out to the three path for the run down the backside, mounted a mild bid mid turn, flattened out in the drive.
