FONDA RONDA TWO unhurried off the pace found stride on the far turn, surged along the inside to grab a short lead in upper stretch then held MOUNTAIN PEARLE at bay in game fashion. MOUNTAIN PEARLE well placed to the backside followed close up firing four deep near the quarter pole, ceded to FONDA RONDA TWO in upper stretch going abreast rival applying all out pressure to wire. COZUMEL sent clear to the backside went measured on pace briefly ceding the lead to WISEMAN'S MILL between calls, trying to assert control on the far turn was overpowered to upper stretch proving no match in drive. SILVER ON GOLD raced evenly tracking the pace through the backside, kept along the inside to upper stretch had no surge under a drive. SUPER DIVA off slowly was outrun through the far turn, had minor improvement when taken six wide in upper stretch. WISEMAN'S MILL laid close early pressuring COZUMEL through the backside, extended in bid on the far turn was worn out entering the stretch. UNSUNG was always outrun. REISS'S HALO ducked out racing very wide through the opening turn, was done after a half mile.
