MOONLIGHT GRAHAM stalked early pressing up on the turn, led in the two path late, dug in gamely. SIX MILLER'S tracked evenly to upper stretch, bore down three wide late, was denied at the wire. DESTINED TO SHINE a step slow through the turn bid belatedly five wide down the stretch. LAGOON pressed on pace to upper stretch, extended at the rail weakened. WORKING ON A DREAM hustled up early pressed inside, losing path in upper stretch was angled out. DENY slow early played no factor. DIXIE RUCKUS chased the pace into upper stretch then wore down. BUZZIN READY racing wide was never involved. MR. SOURLAND was always outrun.
