Footnotes

TONY LANTANA prompted on a short lead through the turn dueled down the stretch getting up late between horses. THE MAYOR pressed between horses early then angled inside on the turn, battled from the two path missing gamely. HESALUCKYBLUFF away slowly gained into upper stretch, angled five then six wide vying gamely to the end. CHIEF WINDSONG tracked evenly through the turn, angled six wide upper stretch giving even late response. SMART TALE slow early raced five wide on the turn then seven wide down the lane gaining some late. DEMPSEY bobbling at the break would save ground struggling throughout. PUNCH THE ODDS pressured the pace through the turn then gave way from the four path in upper stretch. CITY CODE always a step slow would tire.
