LIGHTNING ROAD was forwardly placed from the start, angled out three wide leaving the far turn, drew even vying for the lead mid turn, moved clear at the quarter pole, maintained the lead to the wire racing along the rail under steady pressure. SEAN WHO settled towards the rear racing at mid track, rallied four wide top of the lane, chased the winner to the finish needing a bit more, settled for second best in a good try. STIMULUS PLAN unhurried and trailed for six furlongs, swung five wide into the stretch, was hard ridden and got up late securing third place. VALIENT TENOBOD stalked early on, gained mid turn racing between foes, loomed entering the stretch, battled for a minor award but was outfinished late. DONT TELL KITTEN was hard used making the front, set a pressured pace running in the two path, headed from both sides on the second turn, began to fade turning for home. BANK OF DAD tracked the pace to the far turn, began to chase under urging at the three eighths, tired in upper stretch. JUST FOR FRANK pressed for the lead racing along the rail down the backside, fought hard to the quarter pole, started to fade entering the stretch, used up.
