**Footnotes**

PORTRUSH LADY well placed, patient advance, gained on turn, collared foe top stretch, bore out late under left hand whip, changed to right hand on far outside, regrouped nearing wire, cleared. STICK CLOSE well rated, roused into turn, responded off inside, gained fast to wire. MICROSCOPE came away alertly, made lead, measured to lane, hooked from the outside top stretch, tried to fight back, finally ceded. BUSTEDANDISCUSTED off slowly, sluggish backside, swung out inside the 1/4 pole, mild rally, effort came too late. RUN FOR CONGRESS went evenly, faded off to 1/2, altered course, lacked surge. RAINY LEX raced mid pack, dropped back to 1/2, no factor from there. PEARLY BEADS away slowly, labored along, outrun. GO WITH THE FLOW raced second flight, mild middle move, wide turn, gave way. PINNED broke well, laid close up, loomed to 1/2, wilted on turn.
