OVERPOWER broke alert measuring on a short lead through the turn, cut loose in upper stretch drew out under a drive in the two path. BIG JAY stalked close up through the turn, looming in upper stretch proved no match for the winner holding place in the four path. TRANSACTION sent inside chased close up through the turn, weakened in upper stretch holding the others from the rail. SOVEREIGN ROAD hopped in the air missing the break, played no factor. A. P. SIERRA chased early then dropped from contention on the turn. SMOOTH TOWN showed early speed then gave way on the turn.
