Footnotes

MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION hustled and dueled racing 3 wide and between rivals to the 1/4 pole, went clear into the lane, widened decisively from the furlong pole, won being ridden out. NOBLE RUNNER was unhurried and raced wide down the backstretch, asked near the 1/4 pole, swung 6 wide top of the lane, closed willingly to secure the place position but never threatened the winner. MISSISSIPPI RIVER was sent hard, vied for the lead in a four way battle while racing widest, pressed to the 1/4 pole, failed to keep pace at that point, chased MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION entering the stretch, was under a drive but tired some and settled for show position in a good effort. SIMPLY SPIRITUAL raced evenly towards the rear, roused top of the lane, gained and split foes at the eighth pole, angled to the rail for room, closed mildly in deep stretch. SPOILS OF VICTORY was rated while never far back, tracked a hotly contested pace, angled out at the quarter pole, was put to a drive into the lane, lacked response and never menaced. PAULNPAUL was sent hard, vied for the early lead racing between foes and three wide, chased entering the lane, weakened at the eight pole, used up. FRANKYOUVERYMUCH was pushed hard leaving the gate, dueled along the rail in a four way battle, weakened mid turn, no factor in the stretch.
