**Footnotes**

BOMBAY tracked a soft pace traveling at mid track, rallied mid turn, vied at the quarter pole racing widest in a three way duel, edged clear mid stretch, was then fully extended late to prevail. DIZENER settled in mid pack, asked leaving the far turn, swung six wide entering the stretch, steadily gained on the winner from mid stretch, missed late in a game try. LUHUKATMEGO pressed a soft pace early on, drew even mid turn, vied while between rivals from the quarter pole, tired in deep stretch, settled for third best. SNOOK'S PRIDE set soft fractions early, headed leaving the far turn, battled to the three sixteenths, began to weaken mid stretch, bested rest. BOMBER BEAU showed brief foot, tracked to mid turn, had no response when asked for more. CAST NO SHADOW was outrun to the far turn, went by weary rivals to improve placing, no factor. AMAZING G lacked speed, raced towards the rear throughout, never menaced. MORETHANRISQUE was hustled from the gate, raced wide giving a brief chase, gave way at the quarter pole. SHILOH GOLD was off slowly and trailed going into the first turn, rushed up along the rail entering the backside, soon flattened out leaving the far turn, well beaten. DR. FURLOW lacked speed, raced very wide throughout, dropped far off at the quarter pole, finished well beaten in dull effort.
