WILD INQUIRY stalked early pressing up three deep on the turn, dueled abreast down the lane, got up gamely. MR. BOURBON STREET slow early raced evenly on the turn, bid four wide through the stretch responding willingly to salvage place. ROSESANDASONG sent hard pressed along the inside through the turn, dueled in upper stretch then weakened late. CAST NO SHADOW went evenly, circled five wide to upper stretch, gained a bit late at mid track. HIS NAME WAS RICO slow early came six wide in upper stretch finishing evenly. MAJOR STRIKE chased and pressed on the turn, ducked in jamming rival near the eighth pole. LORD OF THUNDER slow early played no factor. PRINCEOFTHESTORMYC in tight early saved ground to upper stretch, was jammed and taken up at the eighth pole. JOE KNOWS ALL was always outrun. A STEWARDS INQUIRY RESULTED IN MAJOR STRIKE BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED EIGHTH.
