FLIP FLOP broke sharply setting the pace edging away on the turn, moved to a commanding lead in upper stretch being ridden out in the two path. DAYS OF LIGHTNING tracked the pace through the turn chasing a loose FLIP FLOP into upper stretch, no match there held well a clear second best. BILLY'S DILLYBAR away slowly trailed through the turn, had modest response along the inside in upper stretch to improve position. GAME CHANGER showed early speed then retreated on the turn. BLYDE RIVER BOY a step slow early would tire.
