**Footnotes**

EAGER INTENTION made the early lead on the inside, saved ground on a slow pace, kept to task entering stretch, held sway to wire. SLICEOTROUBLE unhurried at back, moved under prompting last turn, blocked behind a wall of horses upper stretch, split rivals late to salvage place. LADY LEAR laid close up, loomed off the leader to stretch, threatened in drive, lacked late response. THAT'S OUTRAGEOUS off slowly, outrun on the backside, swung 7 wide to lane, gave a mild rally to pass tired ones. DYNA MOTION went evenly from gate, edged to leaders on final turn, leveled off under drive. LINE IT UP well back early, labored to lane, passed tiring rivals. IMA HALO a step slow throughout, struggled. CHOCOLATE FACTORY rushed wide into backside, wilted after 1/2. LADY ROYALE raced second flight, tired. BLUSHING CALLER sent hard, pressed pace into backside, chased to 1/4 pole, came up empty top stretch.
