**Footnotes**

RICHWOOD HOPE sent hard, vied in a four way battle down the backside, had the rail turning for home, edged away late under strong handling winning in a very determined manner. MISCONSTRUE unhurried early racing at mid track, swung six wide into the lane, hit stride and was closing fastest of all, proved a willing second best. ATLANTIC RIDER showed good speed, vied for the lead running between rivals, ceded inside the furlong marker, saved good position in hard effort. NOBUDDY rushed early, vied abreast traveling four wide around the bend, started to weaken mid stretch, bested rest. MARSH MADNESS well placed tracking a hotly contested pace, hard ridden into the lane, failed to menace needing more. FREIGHT TRAIN lacked speed, angled out upper stretch, mildly bid but was no real threat. CALL SECURITY was off a step slow, outrun to the quarter pole, found belated stride to improve position, no factor. SWINGING HEATH sent hard, vied early in a four way battle, dropped off coming to the quarter pole, angled out while giving way in upper stretch. ORIENTAL GAMBLER was off slowly, raced wide down the backside being hustled along, weakened from top, of the stretch. SNEAK ME IN raced briefly in mid pack, started to drop off near the quarter pole, well beaten, no factor.
