Footnotes

KISS AND FLY was well handled sitting patient in mid pack, began rally mid turn, came three wide taking aim on GOOD WILL entering the stretch, slowly cut into the margin with every stride, edged clear late wining under a stiff drive. GOOD WILL pressed a solid pace racing in hand to the far turn, moved to the front on the bend, held a clear lead entering the stretch, would stubbornly yield to the winner in deep stretch holding second place in a game effort. SAUDADE raced five wide down the backside, rallied four wide leaving the quarter pole, finished willingly besting rest. SOUTHCOTE ROAD lagged far off the pace, gained momentum mid turn, cut the corner saving ground entering the stretch, finished with interest but never threatened. MORNING PRAYERS well placed stalking early on, asked mid turn, lacked response and weakened in the lane. IMA GIVEN rated and raced in the second flight, roused to no avail, never menaced. SUNDAYINTHESOUTH lacked speed racing at mid track, failed to factor. CHILE TEQUILA held a good tracking position traveling four wide, began to chase under urging leaving the far turn, failed to respond and faltered. RAINE OF COURAGE came out in full stride immediately taking the lead, set a solid opening half, battled on the bend, had nothing left entering the stretch, finishing spent.
