Footnotes

LONG RANGE MISSILE quickly showed in front, set the pace traveling in the two path, pressured by BEAR'S CONDUCTOR at the quarter pole from the inside, repulsed that rival by upper stretch then had to fend off UMBANI from mid stretch, was put to left handed stick and responded to hold safe to the wire. UMBANI stalked the winner throughout, launched bid coming three wide top of the lane, almost drew even mid stretch, could not get by a determined winner coming to the payoff but was easily second best. BEAR'S CONDUCTOR pressed the winner to the quarter pole, began to drop off in upper stretch, no late factor. TAXICAB was always outrun, trailed throughout running mid track.
