RICH HERO was just a step slow leaving the gate, quickly rushed up take control, raced in hand with a clear lead, was never asked for best and won being geared down coming to the payoff. LIGHTNING ROAD unhurried early, angled four wide into the lane, never menaced the winner but was easily second best. STAN THE TAP MAN was rushed making a brief chase mid turn, soon flattened out, no threat. LEOBUSTER broke alertly and held the lead momentarily, chased the winner from mid turn, gave way top of the stretch, well beaten.
