J T'S BAD BOY hustled early, stalked SHINY SHIELD running off the rail, bid mid turn and drew even near the quarter pole, slowly edged away mid stretch and widened late under steady handling. SHINY SHIELD broke alertly, and set the pace, headed by the winner at the quarter pole, fought hard to mid stretch, ceded stubbornly then just lasted saving second place. SHARP STRIKE stalked the runner up down the backside, lost position on the turn, came again splitting foes mid stretch traveling four wide, surged willingly at the finish missing second place in a good effort. MUSTARD SEED drifted wide going down the backside carrying GHOSTOFGLOSSY wider in the early going, bid in tandem top of the lane, was outgamed late vying for a minor award. GHOSTOFGLOSSY was carried out wide near the five eighths pole, bid mid turn and raced four wide entering the stretch, dueled abreast foes for a minor award from the eighth pole, was outfinished late needing more. SAGUARO FLATS well placed from the start, raced up close running towards the inside, failed to respond and tired in the drive. DANCE D'ORO broke alertly in the opening strides but was soon out sprinted, tracked running mid track, put to a stiff drive entering the stretch, failed to menace. HOT APPLE CIDER was a step slow into stride, quickly angled to the rail and saved ground throughout, failed to factor. STORMIN ACE raced in the second flight throughout, never factored. QUICK CARNAGE was always outrun, showed little.
