SINCERE MAN was bumped bobbling briefly at the break, tracked the pace advancing out of the turn to loom at mid track in upper stretch, dueled all out from the sixteenth pole prevailing in game fashion. STASH THE BOOTS slow early fired to contention in upper stretch, looking for room was angled inside near the sixteenth pole hooking SINCERE MAN late missing gamely. FLIP FLOP broke alertly engaging the pace working a short lead to upper stretch, digging in there would give all before ceding between horses late. CRAFTY MATCH saved ground cutting the corner to upper stretch, threatening along the rail moved evenly late. HELLO FROM HEAVEN slow early came six wide in upper stretch giving mile late response. TROPHY ROAD was hustled out chasing then pressing FLIP FLOP dueling abreast that one in upper stretch, extended late would come up short. PROUD HONOREE broke sharply pressuring the pace from the inside through the turn, ceded in upper stretch weakening late. UNCLE TOODIE played no factor. DAKOTA FREEWAY was always outrun.
