Footnotes

CAPTAIN BOB JO JR. was patiently ridden in the early going, launched rally coming five wide into the lane, blew by duelers in deep stretch to win going away. CLEVER EXECUTIVE was never far off a contested pace, moved up entering the stretch racing four wide, vied inside the furlong marker, was no match for the winner and got up late for second place in a game effort. MIKES MONSTER sent hard from the gate, battled for the lead from the start racing between foes, matched strides to deep stretch, was overpowered nearing the wire missing in a solid effort. JEBBEY JR stalked around the bend, bid four wide at the quarter pole, vied abreast rivals from the quarter pole, leveled off late needing more. HOLD THAT APPROVAL rated and raced towards the rear, came six wide into the stretch, closed strongly in deep stretch. GESU was hard used leaving the gate, dueling for the lead to the quarter pole, began to tire mid stretch, no late factor. TIME TELLS ALL was well placed stalking around the turn racing three wide and between foes, began to tire inside the eighth pole. MARKET TUMBLE was briefly in tight shortly after the start and steadied briefly, failed to factor racing towards the inside. GOIN ON A HUNCH varied little racing four to five wide throughout, no threat. BRAVE CHARMER quickly dropped off to trail, drifted wide in upper stretch under a drive, failed to factor.
