HOLY HIGH VIKING pressured the pace through the turn, shook clear in upper stretch holding firm in the three path the final eighth. ONE VOTE went evenly in mid pack through the turn, angled four wide in upper stretch responded late salvaging place. SHAWHAN SELECT raced a step slow in mod pack through the turn, gained five wide in upper stretch finishing evenly. B L'S SAND SHARK bumped at the break was rushed to the early lead, pressed through the turn then wore out in upper stretch. SPEEDY TUXEDO played no factor. LIVELY EXIT veering in at the break was never involved. MANDATE was always outrun. MAJOR ROCK STAR chased early then wavered on the turn giving way to upper stretch. MAJOR STRIKE was always outrun.
