ALRIGHT NOW stalked the early pace, bid four wide into upper stretch, edged to the top then dug in late. SIR HILLARY went evenly off the pace, gained to upper stretch, angled out late getting up on the wire for place. DUBAI CITY went evenly, saved ground to upper stretch, bid willingly from the eighth pole along the rail. TEXPLOSIVE HALL sat close up, pressed to a short lead on the far turn, collared to upper stretch, weakened on the inside late. TRUTHSAYER slow early varied little to upper stretch playing no factor. MYSTERY HUNTER sent clear set a moderate pace, ceded on the far turn then wore out down the stretch. HOOFIN' IT was always outrun. PRIZED LEADER dropped back early, tired.
