BEAUTIFUL VENUE well placed throughout, raced towards the inside saving ground, sat patiently around the bend, waited for room entering the stretch, angled out three to four wide splitting rivals, vied in three way duel from the eighth pole, prevailed late under a stiff drive. FAREENA stalked running three wide down the backside, advanced mid turn, took a slight edge at the quarter pole, angled towards the inside top of the lane, dug in under severe pressure, vied to the wire, was out nodded late, held on to the place position in a very game manner. SI SI MON AMIE nicely rated, was never far off the pace, bid between foes at the quarter pole, swung out wider in upper stretch, almost drew even mid stretch, came to the wire abreast foes, was out gamed in last strides, hard effort. IM CLASSIC QUALITY tracked the pace racing four to five wide going to the half, rallied under a drive entering the stretch, loomed racing widest in upper stretch, failed to sustain bid and flattened out besting rest. BAVARIAN BELLE hustled from the gate, vied for the lead throughout, gained a head lead at the half, dueled around the turn, had the rail entering the stretch, was all done giving way mid stretch, used up. PAY THE MAN stumbled at the break, quickly recovered and rushed to vie for the lead, dueled down the backside, was briefly in tight nearing the far turn and rider took up, lost momentum and never regained stride, no factor in the stretch run.
