Footnotes

CHANCE'S CODE stalked the pace following AARON'S SPECIAL close up through the far turn, drew even abreast rival in upper stretch edging to a late lead then holding while drifting out in the final yards. TRADE SIGNAL off slowly would lose ground throughout coming seven wide in upper stretch, found late traction surging quickly in the final yards to salvage place. HITCH A RIDE unhurried early was angled to mid track in upper stretch finding late response to close in a pedestrian final quarter. TWOBITHUSTLER slow early saved ground finding stride after the fact to close on the rail. AARONS SPECIAL sent clear set the pace posting soft splits through the far turn, collared by CHANCE'S CODE in upper stretch would cede weary. TOMS LITTLE CAT tracked early dropping off on the backside, went evenly through the lane lacking surge. CENTENNIAL'S SONG stalked the pace into the far turn, wavered from the quarter pole giving way into upper stretch. CATS IN ORBIT played no factor. NORTHERN FACTS done early was eased to wire.
