HADAVISION was patiently ridden while trailing to mid turn, asked past the three eighths pole, gained momentum coming five wide into the lane, made a powerful finish to run down OVERANDABEAUTY in deep stretch. OVERANDABEAUTY broke alertly, quickly cleared and set all the pace, appeared to have safe lead at the eighth pole, was run down in last jumps, missed in a hard effort. PAY THE MAN broke well, was taken in hand to stalk going down the backside, put to a drive entering the stretch, failed to menace but gamely outbid others for the show position. A LITTLE WILD rated early running towards the inside on the bend, angled out in upper stretch, did improve placing but never menaced. RUFFAROUNDTHEEDGES settled running at mid track, rallied four wide to loom at the quarter pole, failed to sustain rally and leveled off mid stretch. PHOEBE'S SONG hustled from the gate, raced up close to mid turn, began to retreat entering the stretch, no factor in the drive. SOUTHERN YANKEE rated leaving the gate, bid between foes mid turn, held menacing position at the quarter pole, soon weakened in upper stretch fading to last.
