HENNYVILLE settled along the rail in mid pack, sat patient to top of the lane, swung five wide under a drive and quickly accelerated, blew by duelers inside the furlong marker, won going away being ridden out. EMMA'S HOLY BEE broke out and brushed CLEARLY JIMILEE leaving the gate, rushed hard soon after, duled racing three wide around the bend, put a head in front mid stretch, was unable to hold off the winner holding place in a good effort. COLARFUL SONG broke well racing up close from the start, saved ground around the bend, loomed from upper stretch, needed a bit more late gaining third place. CABS ARE HERE hustled from the gate, stalked while in hand to top of the lane, angled four wide top of the stretch, vied briefly in a four way battle, leveled off being outfinished for a minor award. PATH OF PRIDE broke alertly but was soon headed for the lead, battled to mid stretch then weakened besting rest. PAY THE BILLS lacked speed running along the rail, roused entering the lane, found stride mid stretch and showed belated interest but failed to threaten. BLUEGRASS ANGEL lacked speed racing at mid track, varied little never factoring. LE FEU D'SUAVE lacked speed raced between foes mid turn towards the rear, offered little. CLEARLY JIMILEE was brushed by EMMA'S HOLY BEE leaving the gate, was soon outrun racing wide, never involved.
