Footnotes

GREY ALYCATTAs unhurried early responded into upper stretch surging clear on the inside of trio of rivals holding firm late in the three path. GRAN TIRO stalked a loose leader through the far turn, bid between horses at mid track in upper stretch being outfinished from the inside while securing place. STARLITS TOUCH sent clear set the pace on moderate splits through the far turn, overpowered in upper stretch would weaken in the four path. IRISHWOODS raced a step slow through the far turn improving modestly in the three path down the stretch. L'S LEGACY raced evenly through the far turn, bid six wide in upper stretch weakening late. MCBEAN slow early played no factor. EL PATRONE dropping back early was always outrun. NO ORDINARY GUY showed little.
