SILENT NOTE laid close up, given patient handling, went evenly to 1/4 pole, surged at mid track when asked, collared foe approaching the wire, went in tandem last strides, got up gamely. MORE D'AMOUR came away alertly, prompted pace at rail, dueled to short lead inside the 1/8 pole, hooked late, battled to wire, determined, missed. ONE TO FIVE broke sharply, pressed through turn, extended into lane, showed signs of fatigue, shortened stride late. BIG DEAL sluggish early, pushed along 5 wide, mild rally lane, no menace. SWEET SINGING SAMI dropped back early, labored to stretch, modest move, no factor. CONQUESTALITY outrun early, varied little throughout. SPIRIT OF FLAG hustled to front, retreated on turn, empty.
