PROUD MCKEE was bumped by FIDDLERS JINGO at the start, rushed up three wide drawing even with that rival mid turn, vied in a four way battle at the quarter pole, was passed mid stretch losing position, surged in last strides coming again to get up for a hard earned victory. EVAN'S EMERALD was taken in hand from the gate and moved off the rail, rallied five wide at the quarter pole and vied for the lead racing abreast foes, edged clear mid stretch, hung nearing the wire being outfinished missing out on the victory. BEAT THE FREEZE rated early and trailed to top of the stretch, angled out five wide with a furlong to go, hit stride late and finished strongly just missing second place. SNOWBOARD RIDGE raced up close from the start, hugged the rail throughout, vied in a five wide battle top of the lane, remained a threat to deep stretch but was out kicked in last jumps. FIDDLERS JINGO broke out bumping PROUD MCKEE at the start, rushed up set to a pressured pace, headed form both sides mid turn, fought hard to deep stretch, yielded stubbornly in a good try. KING T C well placed tracking a hotly contested pace, angled out sic wide taking aim on duelers in upper stretch, failed to menace despite being hard ridden. TRUE REBEL was brushed in a chain reaction leaving the gate, raced up close running four wide, vied briefly at the quarter pole traveling between foes, stopped in upper stretch, was vanned off after the finish.
