RULER BOY patiently ridden early, launched bid coming four wide into the lane, finally edged clear in deep stretch, won driving. SIX MILLER'S stalked down the backside, bid near the quarter pole, gained a slight lead mid stretch, ceded stubbornly to the winner in deep stretch, missed in a hard try. STARLITS LAD showed good speed, had the rail vying for the lead entering the stretch, yielded grudgingly. JUSTICE COWBOY was slow into stride and trailed down the backside, improved placing but never factored. DOLCE LUSSO gave chase running along the rail, gave way top of the stretch. DAVID B. pressed hard for the lead soon after the start, began to fade top of the lane, finished spent. CIVIL CHALLENGE was outrun, showed little.
