Footnotes

RED OAK RIDGE broke sharply to an easy lead being measured through the turn, opening the margin in upper stretch was taken in hand late. TIME TIX AHEAD hustled on the inside moved in close quarters early, chased a loose leader to upper stretch angling out a bit while securing place. BAD POWER slow early saved ground to upper stretch gaining then holding position late. RHETORIC a step slow through the turn made a mild gain with even action in upper stretch, lacked late surge. OH SO LO slow early played no factor finishing near mid track. POLISH SAUSAGE was never involved. GRAND NANO raced evenly through the turn then faded in the three path down the stretch. PLEASANT MAN raced second flight tiring in upper stretch. C NORTHERN LIGHTS was always outrun. UNEXPECTEDDIVIDEND chased the pace through the turn then gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
