SCARLET BALL stalked traveling three wide to the far turn, bid mid turn to vie for the lead, drove clear turning for home, continued to widen running along the rail to the wire, won easily being ridden out. AT HEAVENS DOOR hustled to the top, set the pace racing along the inside, headed by the winner mid turn, proved no match from upper stretch, shortened stride late just saving second place. LADY CHILL settled in the second flight, angled four wide into the lane, surged nearing the wire just missing second place but never threatened the winner. NORTH FOREST LADY raced sluggishly for six furlongs, swung out five wide entering the stretch, showed some belated interest improving position but never factored. ABERNATHY rated traveling in the second flight, made a mild bid mid turn, chased form the quarter pole, failed to sustain move and flattened out mid stretch. MI DULCE KOKO varied little running towards the rear, no factor. MISMATCHED SOCKS raced mid pack along the rail, gave way at the quarter pole finishing well beaten. IN SHORT ORDER pressed the runner up briefly, began to chase leaving the far turn, stopped top of the stretch, finished spent.
