SPEAK OUT raced up close along the inside, sat patient to mid turn, angled 4 wide near the 1/4 pole, bid while still in hand, took the lead in upper stretch, drew off under brisk hand urging. JOLIE rated along in mid pack racing off the rail, roused near the 1/4 pole, rallied 4 wide top of the lane, closed well in the drive for the place position. ROYAL PET rushed to set a pressured pace throughout, raced slightly off the rail, collared by SPEAK OUT near the 1/4 pole, tried to dig in but was no match for that rival, remained under a drive in the lane but got outrun late for the place position. QUEENOFMOUNTAIN went along under a rating in mid pack, roused near the 1/4 pole, made a slight gain while angling towards the rail in upper stretch, leveled off in deep stretch under a drive. TONY'S GIRL hustled up the rail to press for the early lead along the inside, chased entering the stretch, was hard ridden but lacked needed rally. EARLY SIGNAL slow from the gate, raced off the rail, asked but offered little. TOY FOR ROY slow early along the inside, asked and swung widest into the stretch, was under a drive but failed to gain any ground. STORMY CONQUEST showed good speed from the gate, stalked outside of ROYAL PET to mid turn, weakened from there, gave way in upper stretch, was not persevered with in the stretch run.
