Footnotes

NICE SHOES rated in the second flight, asked leaving the quarter pole, came five wide into the lane, hit best stride late, surged in last jumps to get the nod under a stiff drive. LIVELY EXIT stalked racing four wide early, bid at the quarter pole, was under an all out drive in the stretch run, put a head in front coming to the finish, was out nodded, very hard effort. TANT rushed to set a pressured pace, was involved in a three way duel mid turn, dug in to vie to the sixteenth pole, raced along the rail, ceded grudgingly late, game effort. HAINI I SWELL well placed, raced a little off the rail, put to a drive at the quarter pole, was hard ridden but needed more in deep stretch, bested rest. REQRAAQ hustled and pressed throughout, bid and vied between foes at the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid and tired upper stretch. PROTECT HER HERMAN was slow into stride, raced off the rail mid turn, did improve position but was no factor. ARNIE lacked speed, raced towards the inside down the backside, angled mid turn, did make a brief gain, leveled off in the drive. MASTER THE GAME sent hard, vied along the rail to mid turn, faded at the quarter pole, used up. RED RIVER was in tight and bumped soon after the the start, raced wide down the backside, dropped off into the lane, no factor.
