Footnotes

TROUT RIVER RED broke alertly, vied in a four way battle going down the backstretch, edged away near the quarter pole, remained off the rail turning for home, was kept to steady pressure, held firm. DIXIE'S JUBILEE rushed from the gate, dueled inside a trio of rivals early but moved off the rail going down the backside, lost the lead to TROUT RIVER RED near the quarter pole, dug in under severe pressure to battle back to gain the place position late, very hard effort. A LITTLE WILD tracked a heated speed duel racing five wide, rallied leaving the quarter pole, loomed in upper stretch, needed more late, was out finished for the place position in last jumps. ZOOMING BY sent hard, vied going down the backside racing between rivals, dropped off slightly entering the stretch, angled wider in upper stretch, finished willingly. BALLAD OF BERTIE unhurried early, sat patient to the quarter pole, rallied between foes upper stretch, moved to a threatening position mid stretch, lacked needed late kick. KITTY KISSES pressed for the lead shortly after the start, vied to mid turn, was between foes near the quarter pole, caught in tight and had to steady briefly, could not regain momentum, tired late. V. I. P. PRINCESS moved to the rail shortly after the start, rushed a bid to almost draw even at the three eighth pole running along the rail, failed to sustain rally, gave way in upper stretch.
