Footnotes

DAKOTA FREEWAY well handled early, saved ground to the quarter pole, challenged for the entering the stretch, edged clear and moved out three wide in upper stretch, held firm under steady pressure. ALRIGHT NOW tracked the pace under a rating, rallied five wide under strong right handed stick into the lane, finished willingly securing the place position. JIMMY JAMMER unhurried early racing in the second flight, split rivals mid turn, angled to the rail entering the stretch, finished with interest but needed more late. FOUR FLUSH lacked speed, raced mid track, roused from the quarter pole, angled a bit inside to split foes in upper stretch, gave belated bid to improve placing. SIR SPEEDATOR pressed for the lead down the backside, edged clear at the quarter pole, began to shorten stride inside the furlong marker. ONE LAST LOOK sent hard making the lead shortly after the start, headed mid turn, fought while dueling between foes at the quarter pole, had enough giving way mid stretch. CAPTAIN PETE raced up close briefly, began to chase from mid turn, came five wide entering the stretch, no late factor. CAVALIA lacked speed, raced wide down the backside, failed to factor. RACING AUTHORITY trailed soon after the start, was hard ridden failing to respond, never involved.
