COHEN THEBARBARIAN broke sharply setting all the pace in the three path, a bit weary nearing the wire held up. AKAPESCHE stalked the pace through the turn, bid four path down the lane, edged closer late. FULL HORSE POWER went evenly through the turn, bid willingly five wide down the stretch. SIX MILLER'S slow early saved ground to upper stretch, vied hard in two path late. CHIEF INSPECTOR slow early came six wide upper stretch, had some late gain. PLEASANT MAN dropped back on the turn. CLEVER PRIDE hustled early, wore out. RAPID RIDERS was always outrun. COWBOY DAVE labored throughout.
