Footnotes

ALWAYS IN LOVE pressured the pace locking up inside of POWER SWEEP for the stretch run, dug deep keeping a head in front late brushing at the wire. POWER SWEEP pressured the pace three deep then abreast ALWAYS IN LOVE on the turn, bore down outside that one through the lane giving all in close quarters brushing at the end. SIR ROMEO raced evenly through the turn angling six wide in upper stretch, looming outside the leaders would hang late. TAKE AIM hustled early between horses would cede on the turn, came again along the rail upper stretch threatening but lacking a final surge. DAKOTA FREEWAY slow early was taken eight wide upper stretch closing the gap late. LIL PERFECT STORM slow early was swung nine wide in upper stretch gaining some ground after the fact. PORT CLYDE was never involved finishing in the two path.
