Footnotes

KINGOFTHEBLUEGRASS well rated angled out on the backside advancing five deep on the far turn, wrested the lead in upper stretch going clear then withstood a late run from FLAMIN' HOT to prevail. FLAMIN' HOT unhurried early gained ground on the far turn, floated out to the eight path upper stretch was surging quickly in the last yards arriving too late. SNEAKIN THRU saved ground gaining on the backside, chased on the far turn cutting the corner to upper stretch, continued with steady response from the rail vying willingly to the end. WOTAN rated near the back was circled out losing ground to upper stretch, responded there in the eight path finding best after the fact. GENERALISSIMO raced evenly at mid pack through the backside, pressed up to challenge on the far turn, extended in bid from the three path down the lane coming up a bit short. MORAL COMPASS unhurried early gained contention on the far turn, looming in the seven path upper stretch would angled in toward mid track while hanging late. REZIF slow early gained a bit as the field bunched up on the far turn, raced six and seven wide down the lane failing to menace. DYNAMITE BOB slow early played no factor racing ten wide through the stretch. THE ALCOVA KID hustled up early was used hard wrestling a slim lead carrying it through the far turn, wavered into upper stretch giving way near the rail. CHIEF COMPLAINT prompted the pace pressing hard through the far turn, was steadied in traffic at the head of the stretch giving way soon after. STRAIT STRIPE was hustled along staying close to the far turn, began to waver there giving way eight wide in upper stretch. THUNDERESTIMATE rushed to lead early was all done after a half mile, would ease to upper stretch.
