Footnotes

PRICE OF HONOUR raced up close from the start, was in tight far turn, stalked leader to the 1/4 pole, angled out and bid from there, went clear in upper stretch, held firm under a drive. SECRET ROMEO was off slowly, moved well off the rail soon after the start, asked mid turn, rallied 5 wide top of the lane, closed strongly throughout the drive. FRANKIE R'S WINNER hustled from the gate, stalked and pressed while 4 wide early racing between rivals, was hard ridden in the stretch run but failed to gain ground late. WIREBENDER showed high speed from the gate, set all the pace, collared near the 1/4 pole, battled to mid stretch, weakened from there. MCNELLIS sent hard, stalked while 3 wide and between foes on the turn, asked for more in the lane, failed to rally, finished evenly. WHEEL'NDEAL'NJOHN well placed while 4-5 wide early, tracked on the turn, roused near the 1/4 pole, gave no response. RAN SOUTH hustled up the inside soon after the start, was in tight and had to steady briefly on the turn, remained evenly thereafter. TWIN METEORS sent hard, pressed and chased while 5 wide early, was hard ridden into the lane, weakened mid stretch. WEDONIT raced wide, never involved. The inquiry sign was posted followed by an objection by the rider of RAN SOUTH against the rider of PRICE OF HONOUR for interference on the turn was disallowed by the stewards.
