**Footnotes**

TETON STAR quickly showed in front, set all the pace receiving pressure around the bend and keeping TUFFY COTTRELL in close quarters along the rail, was asked for more top of the lane, responded to increase margin and won being kept to task. TUFFY COTTRELL raced up close to the winner running in close quarters along the rail, angled out mid stretch being put to a drive, was no late threat finishing a willing second best. READY TO TANGO rated early and raced along the rail to top of the stretch, angled out under a drive, finished in willing manner gaining the show position. WERBLIN FRIEND rushed into the turn, pressed TETON STAR around the turn, was bumped by TUFFY COTTRELL in upper stretch, weakened late. DREAM VICTORY lacked speed racing off the rail, was hard ridden leaving the quarter pole, failed to respond. FOREMAN tracked the pace traveling three to four wide around the bend, began to fade mid stretch, no late factor.
