ECONOMIC SWOON broke well stalking the leader traveling in the three path, slowly wore down ROYAL RDER SECRET in last jumps gaining a hard earned victory. ROYAL RED SECRET broke alertly and angled towards the inside, set a pressured pace throughout, dug in under severe pressure from mid stretch, was edged out in last jumps. DANCENSING hustled from the gate, vied for the early lead, was in tight and checked going into the far turn losing position, stalked top pair around the bend, put to a drive in upper stretch running along the rail, lacked needed rally besting rest. ATLANTA was brushed by TAKE IT HOME DON leaving the gate, settled in the second flight, was hard ridden traveling mid track entering the stretch, lacked rally. TAKE IT HOME DON bobbed slightly and broke inward brushing ATLANTA, rushed a four wide move mid turn, loomed briefly at the quarter pole, weakened from mid stretch. EL WINDO trailed form the start racing mid track, offered little. LIVINGSTON'S GHOST angled to the rail shortly after the start, showed little. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS SOON FOLLOWED BY A CLAIM OF FOUL FROM THE TRAINER OF DANCENSING AGAINST THE RIDER OF ROYAL RED SECRET FOR INTERFERENCE ON THE TURN, AFTER REVIEWING THE TAPE, THE STEWARDS DISMISSED THIS CLAIM AND RESULTS STOOD AS IS. .
