ACT TOO was hard used vying for control, edged clear mid stretch racing along the rail, was tiring coming to the wire and held on under an all out drive. PAPA VITO was forwardly placed from the start, angled four wide top of the lane, surged in last jumps to just miss in a game effort. SABREHAWK rushed into the far turn, raced abreast a pair of rivals mid turn, put a head in front at the quarter pole, lost the lead in upper stretch, fought hard to the wire but was outgamed late but saved the show position. MARYLOVESTETON rated early and angled to the rail, cut the corner turning for home, closed in coming to the wire, missed a minor award in a game try. NOEQUAL settled in the second flight racing mid track, angled out to the five path mid stretch under a stiff drive, needed more late. FIRE HOUSE BLITZ battled in a three way duel mid turn racing between rivals, began to fade from mid stretch, used up. ALTA BOY settled in the second flight, raced mid track throughout, failed to respond when asked, never menaced. STARLITS LAD was quickly outrun, dull effort.
