Footnotes

WINNING APPROACH sent to the front, battled abreast rivals through the turn, even terms entering stretch, edged clear late . LIVE BACKWARDS sent hard, ran up between horses to force the pace, battled into the lane, ceded late on the inside . MISS IDA BELLE laid close up early, dropped off dueling trio on the turn, continued on in even fashion to outbid others . MISS SIG slow early on, blocked angled inside near the 3/8 pole, failed to mount a serious bid . EYE OF Z STORM used early speed along the inside, clung to a slim edge on the turn, fully extended into the stretch, finally wore down and faded . DIANA MOSELEY always a step slow, was never involved . SUPREME SONG bumped lightly at the start, raced at mid pack into the turn, angled out, folded upper stretch . SILENT GLORY struggled throughout .
