FOMO broke alertly setting the pace under pressure through the turn, digging in from the three path found more late edging clear. AVIYAH SHINES hustled out chased then pressured the pace through the turn, extending in the four path down the stretch proved no match late hanging on for place. WILDCAT JOANN slow early trailed through the turn, came five wide in upper stretch responding finishing well while angling in a bit late. SUPERTUNIA saved ground proving no menace while gaining some position. BELLARIFFIC gave hard pursuit through the turn then faded near mid track in upper stretch. STARSHIP SPIRIT hustled inside angled to the four path in upper stretch giving way there. BLAZIN' BLUES dropped back on the turn, tired drifting seven wide in upper stretch.
