**Footnotes**

LADY GRACE broke alertly to go clear to the opening turn, maintained a healthy margin saving ground through the far turn, angled off the inside in upper stretch, went unchallenged through the lane winning handily. ENTICE ME broke well to follow LADY GRACE from the break, moved alertly stalking quick splits through the backside, cut into the margin somewhat on the far turn, would prove no match in drive holding well a willing second best. MAID OF HONOR away slowly, was outrun varying little to the far turn, roused with response from the 1/4 pole, gave good late stride finishing well after the fact. SUNSHINE SUMMER raced evenly in second flight, roused leaving the backstretch, responded with a brief move in upper stretch, leveled off late along the inside. BELLA BELLA BAILEY outrun early, labored along through the far turn, swung wide for drive, had enough to best others. SAPPHIRE HILL hustled out going wide on the opening turn, lost ground tracking to the 1/2, extended the bid chasing on the far turn, wore down at the head of the lane. SHAHALIE LAKE varied little off the pace playing no factor. SHARP WAYS rushed wide through the opening turn, continued to lose ground throughout wearing down into the stretch. MERRY GREY sent early, chased for a 1/2 mile before folding up. QUIET CHARM struggled throughout offering little.
