ONE FINE ENDEAVOUR pressed for the lead from the start, drew even entering the stretch, edged away mid stretch then held sway late under strong encouragement. BOYS KISS N'TELL forwardly placed stalking traveling three to four wide near the quarter pole, was slowly getting to the winner in deep stretch, needed a but more proving a game second best. SHICAGO SENSATION broke sharply, was pressured by ONE FINE ENDEAVOUR around the turn, ceded grudgingly upper stretch, fought hard to deep stretch, faded late holding on to third place. MASHARKA stalked along the rail soon after the start, hard ridden giving chase from the quarter pole, lacked rally and was no late threat. YOU DA MANDATE varied little racing at mid track, no threat. MONTE BAJO (FR) was slow into stride, raced wide throughout, failed to factor.
