CANYON DRIVE well rated gave a prompted move on the far turn emerging to even terms six wide in upper stretch, extended under a stiff drive edged up late. IT'S ABOUT IMAGE away slowly fired to contention on the far turn, bid abreast rivals seven wide down the lane needing all late to salvage place. ROSA PANTERA stalked a loose leader through the far turn closing to put a head in front upper stretch, dueled four and five wide the final eighth ceding grudgingly to wide pressure. DARBOY slow early saved ground cutting the corner to contention in upper stretch, all out along the rail held reasonably well late. HONOUR ABOVE SELF hustled clear moved off on pace carrying the lead to the far turn, reeled in there hung in for a while before weakening late. HIGH SIGN slow early circled out to upper stretch finishing evenly at mid track. GREELEY'S GOLD tracked evenly to the half, wavered on the far turn dropping from contention. RAILROAD settled early was roused from the half, gave little response angling in from mid track upper stretch laboring home. COUNTRY HUMOR was always outrun. DANCER'S LEGACY gave way after a half mile.
