Footnotes

CORKING TULIP broke well, laid close up, patient to 1/2, fired when asked into turn, collared foe mid stretch, wore down rival driving. DEMONS GRACE came away alertly, set slow splits, cut loose on turn, hooked on the inside mid lane, fought back fully extended, ceded last yards. VALERINA slow early, saved ground, angled off inside, mild rally stretch, outbid others. HIGH HOPES IRISH hustled off pace, edged closer turn, extended for drive, showed fatigue inside the 1/4 pole, bumped mid lane, little left. R. D. SUNSHINE rushed inside, pursued hard through backside, swerved in then out mid stretch, bumped foe inside the 1/8 pole. GALLANT BABY well placed, tracked to 1/2, faded odd into turn, no menace after. CRIED TOO BLUE caught wide early, lost ground backside, flattened out turn. VERT 'N' MERT raced at mid pack, roused from 1/2, weakened. LISA BE COOL dropped well back, labored. SO SOFT SUZY hustled wide, tired.
